#### **PLEASE NOTE:**

**Natural trees only. No artificial trees. All lights, decorations, and tree stands/bases must be removed. You must remove any plastic bags that you have the tree in.**

### **Red Oak Christmas Tree Removal Service**

Those that do not recycle their Christmas Tree and have Red Oak remove them must prepay \$25 for the tree to be removed on the scheduled day. Trees must be properly prepared to be removed, or the tree will be left and another \$25 trip charge will apply. Trees must be cut into sections shorter than 3 feet in length. Multiple cuts may be necessary.
